Booking for Sunday Mass. We are asking people who wish to attend Mass on Saturday evening or on Sunday to book a place in advance. This is for two main reasons: to limit the number of people at Mass (the Government has placed a cap of 50 on any church service) and to provide us with a list of attendees for "track and trace" purposes. If anyone has difficulty in using the online booking service, please speak to a passkeeper at Mass or phone Father, and we'll be happy to help.

Remember that for the foreseeable future no one has an obligation to attend Sunday Mass. People who are more vulnerable can of course follow services around the country online. It is also possible to make your "weekly Mass" one of the weekday Masses, which have only a small number of participants.

Please refrain from booking several Sundays in a row, as this might make it more difficult for other people to book a place at Sunday Mass.

Readers today: To be chosen from parishioners accustomed to, or wishing to do readings, who are present in the congregation. (Rotas being worked on...)

Offertory Collection: The offertory collection for each Sunday will not be counted until later in the week, to allow for possible coronavirus contamination of the notes and coinage to die off.

Standing Orders: At this time, supporting your parish by means of a standing order, instead of putting money into the collection at Mass, would be particularly helpful. For taxpayers, this can be aift-aided – then we get 20% of whatever you give in addition from the Government! If you're interested in setting up a standing order, e-mail Father with your postal address, and we'll send you by physical post the details you need to arrange payments with your bank.
