## FOR BOTH PARISHES

**First Holy Communion classes** in our parishes resume this weekend for the children that would have made their first Communion earlier this year, but for the Covid pandemic. For details see below under each parish.

**Confirmation.** Classes for older children (primary Year 7 and above) preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation are planned for later this year or the beginning of next year. Please let Fr. Bruno or Mrs Anne Reilly (Fraserburgh) or Mrs Margaret Wyness (Peterhead) know about any children who need to register for these classes.

**November – month of remembrance.** November is the month when, by tradition, we pray for the eternal rest of our deceased relatives and friends. This year, in all our churches, we remember especially those who have died during the pandemic. We also pray for those who have lost someone they loved, for those who were unable to say goodbye, and for those who are suffering the pain of grief. We pray for confidence in the loving mercy of God, for faith in the Resurrection to new life, and for the hope of being reunited in God's kingdom.

Our purple **Book of Remembrance** is available at the back of the church. You are invited to write in it the names of any deceased persons you would like included in our special intentions during November. **All Masses in the parishes during November that do not have a specific intention attached to them will be offered for the repose of the souls of those recorded in these books, or whom you bear in your hearts.**
