We pray for confidence in the loving mercy of God, for faith in the Resurrection to new life, and for the hope of being reunited in God's kingdom.

**All Masses in the parishes during November that do not have a specific intention attached to them will be offered for the repose of the souls of those recorded in our purple Book of Remembrance, or whom you bear in your hearts.**
