EU Settlement Scheme – DEADLINE APPROACHING: 30th June 2021 is the deadline for applications to be made to the EU Settlement Scheme (EUSS). All EU, EEA and Swiss citizens and their family members who were resident in the UK by 31st December 2020, should apply without delay, at

www.gov.uk/eusettlementscheme

so that they can continue to work, study, and access free healthcare and benefits in the UK after 30th June 2021. An application must be made for every eligible child within a family. Parents should check if they need to apply to the EU Settlement Scheme for their children, even if they have already applied and been granted a status themselves.

The Northern Pilgrimage: Thurso, 3rd July 21. You are invited to the Pilgrims' Way Mass on Saturday 3rd July in St Anne's Thurso at 12:30pm.

The Northern Saints Pilgrimage had its origins in a meeting of 'The Caithness Book Club' in St Anne's church hall. While reading *'Together in Christ: Following the Northern Saints'* by John Woodside, a member noticed that there were nine saints with Caithness connections, only two had she heard of. These were Saint Fergus the patron saint of Wick and St Magnus of Orkney. Out of this came "The Northern Saints Trail".

On Sat 29 May the first Pilgrimage North Service was held at the St Duthac's Collegiate Church at Tain. The 3 July 21 Pilgrimage Mass at St Anne's, Thurso will be our opportunity as Catholics to make our contribution to establishing the Pilgrimage Route. The 3rd July is the Feast of St Thomas the Apostle – it is also the anniversary of Fr Colin Davis' Ordination to the Priesthood. Fr Colin will preside, and Fr James Bell will be the homilist. After lunch there will be an opportunity for the more mobile pilgrims to have a guided tour of Old St Peter's, a pre-Reformation church site in Thurso, now maintained by Historic Scotland. The Moderator of

the General Assembly of the Church of Scotland will give a short talk after lunch.
