Bill to introduce Legalised Assisted Suicide. A public consultation has been launched on a bill proposed by Liam McArthur MSP to legalise assisted suicide in Scotland. It is important that as many people as possible respond to this consultation. We must send a strong message to Mr. McArthur, MSPs and the Scottish Government: that assisted suicide is a dangerous and unethical practice that must never be legalised in Scotland or any other part of the UK. The consultation is running until Wednesday 22nd December 2021. Please complete questionnaire as soon as you can and encourage others to do the same. Synod 2021-2023. "The Church of God is convoked in Synod." With this convocation, Pope Francis invites the whole Church to question itself on synodality.

Synods of bishops are held in Rome every few years, and are presided over by the Pope. Several hundred bishops from around the world meet together to discuss important topics like the family, young people, evangelisation... Afterwards the Pope sums up their discussions and writes something on the theme to guide the Church.

The next synod of bishops is scheduled for 2023, and Pope Francis would like every Catholic in the world to be involved. Its theme is "synodality".

What does synodality mean? It means meeting together to see how we can better travel together along Christ's way.

So the 2023 Synod of Bishops is looking at how the Church journeys together and how this can be improved.

Why is this Synod important? Pope Francis mentions 3 opportunities that it brings:

- "that of moving not occasionally but structurally towards a synodal Church, an open square where all can feel at home and participate"
- 2. "the opportunity to become a listening Church, to break out of our routine and pause... in order to stop and listen. To listen to the Spirit... To listen to our brothers and sisters speak of their hopes and of the crises of faith present in different parts of the world, of the need for a renewed pastoral life and of the signals we are receiving from those on the ground..."
- 3. "it offers us the opportunity to become a *Church of closeness*... Let us keep going back to God's own 'style', which is closeness, compassion and tender love... Not only with words, but by a presence that can weave greater bonds of friendship with society and the world. A Church that does not stand aloof from life, but immerses herself in today's problems and needs, bandaging wounds and healing broken hearts with the balm of God" (Address 09.10.21).

We'll be hearing about the Synod regularly over coming months – and, of course, **getting involved**, so that our voices also can be heard.
