"As we initiate this process, we too are called to become experts in the art of encounter. Not so much by organizing events or theorizing about problems, as in taking time to encounter the Lord and one another. Time to devote to prayer and to adoration – that form of prayer that we so often neglect – devoting time to adoration, and to hearing what the Spirit wants to say to the Church. Time to look others in the eye and listen to what they have to say, to build rapport, to be sensitive to the questions of our sisters and brothers, to let ourselves be enriched by the variety of charisms, vocations and ministries. Every encounter – as we know – calls for openness, courage and a willingness to let ourselves be challenged by the presence and the stories of others. A second important element in our Synod journey is listening. "True encounter arises only from listening Jesus simply listens, for whatever amount of time it takes; he is not rushed. Most importantly, he is not afraid to listen with his heart and not just with his ears. Indeed, he does more than simply answer the rich man's question; he lets him tell his story to speak freely about himself.
