**Registration is now open for children who wish to make their first Holy Communion in 2023, and those who wish to be Confirmed in 2023.**

**The Church's World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly 2022** takes place this Sunday, 24<sup>th</sup> July.

In a decree published on Monday, the Apostolic Penitentiary – the Vatican tribunal responsible for issues relating to mercy and the forgiveness of sins in the Church – announced several grants of indulgences for those taking part in the second World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly.

A plenary indulgence, which may also be obtained in suffrage for the souls in Purgatory, is granted:

– to grandparents, the elderly, and the faithful who, motivated by a true spirit of penance and charity, will participate on July 24<sup>th</sup> in the solemn celebration that Pope Francis will preside over in the Vatican, or in the various functions that take place throughout the world;

– to the faithful who, on the same day, devote adequate time to visit, in person or virtually through the media, their disabled brothers and sisters in need or in difficulty (such as the sick, the lonely, or the disabled)

– to the sick elderly and to all those who, unable to leave their homes for a serious reason, will unite spiritually with the sacred services of the World Day, offering to our merciful God their prayers, the pains and sufferings of their lives, especially while the words of the Supreme Pontiff and the various celebrations are broadcast through the media

The grants of indulgence, "from the heavenly treasures of the Church," are made under the usual conditions of sacramental Confession, Eucharistic confession, and prayers for the intentions of the Pope.

Pope Francis established the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly in 2021, setting its observance for the fourth Sunday in July, the Sunday nearest the feast of Saints Anne and Joachim, grandparents of Jesus.

**Help protect women and children from abortion by defending pro-life vigils in Scotland.**

A public consultation has been launched on a bill proposed by Gillian MacKay MSP to bring in buffer zones around facilities that provide abortions in Scotland.

Ms MacKay's proposals would **criminalise all pro-life activities** in the vicinity of abortion facilities. It is important that as many people as possible respond to this consultation. The consultation is running until **Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> August 2022.**
