Scammers Are About... Unfortunately, it seems that the scammer-impersonators have turned their attention to us again. They're sending out **fake emails** to some of our parishioners asking them to click on this or that link or get in touch with them, **pretending that the email is from Fr. Bruno. Here are some guiding rules for dealing with these scammers safely:**

1. If you're at all suspicious, always phone the parish or Fr. Bruno directly to confirm that the message is genuine.
2. Never click on any links in a suspicious message.
3. Most importantly, parish **staff will never email parishioners except from the official parish email account, which is peterfraser@rcda.scot**. So messages from fake addresses, like **onlinechurch37592@gmail...** etc. **should definitely be ignored.**
