Youth2000 is an organization that aims to bring young Catholics together and set their heart on fire for Jesus through Adoration, worship, and communal friendship. The Summer Festival is usually the biggest program they organise every year with about 500 to 600 attendees from all over the UK at the beautiful Ampleforth Abbey. Registration closes on or before 11th August 2023. Transport will be arranged from St. Mary's Cathedral if there's enough uptake, so it's important contact is made with our diocesan youth leaders via Fr. Bishop Kenneth Nowakowski of the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of the Holy Family in the UK will preach at the Mass, and the Choir of the Ukrainian Catholic community in Scotland will participate in the Mass along with the Motherwell Diocesan Choir.
