**Solemnity of All Saints.** Please note that this Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> November is the Solemnity of All Saints, and a **Holy Day of Obligation**.

**We come together as a community to offer the Sacrifice of the Lamb of God to the Father for the redemption of the world, for ourselves, and those dear to us.** We remember in particular on this day all those **noble souls** who served the Lord heroically during their lives on earth, and who are now among the choirs of the **Saints in Heaven**, forever singing God's praises.

**Catholic trivia:** "hallow-eeen" means "the evening before All Hallows", that is, All Saints! Originally, it would have been a moment to prepare for the Solemnity and perhaps to go to the Vigil Mass. ☺
