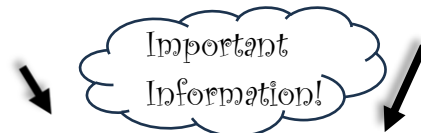
Taxpayers: You might consider supporting the Parish in the new tax year by signing up to the Gift Aid Scheme, if you have not already done so. All you need do is sign one form and the rest is done for you. For every £1 you give, the Parish receives a further 25p from HMRC, at no cost to you. Forms are available from Fr. Bruno/Marta in Peterhead or Norma/Pet in Fraserburgh.

Altar Server's Practice for Holy Week/Easter. Servers in both parishes should participate in a practice for Holy Week and Easter in **St. Mary's Church**, at 4pm on **Saturday 23rd March.**

The Good Friday Walk of the Cross – will commence at 6.00am, from St. Mary's Cathedral, 20 Huntly Street, Aberdeen AB10 1SH. Those taking part should meet at 5.45am in the cathedral car park from where the walk will start. People are therefore asked to park their cars out-with the cathedral car park, as that area will be closed to vehicles. The walk will finish at the top of Kincorth Hill, approx. 2.5miles away. Walkers are advised to come properly prepared, with suitable clothing and shoes.

Chrism Mass. The annual diocesan Chrism Mass, at which the Bishop blesses the oils used for the Sacraments in the coming year, and the clergy renew

their promises before God, will be held this year at **St. Mary's Cathedral, Aberdeen, on Thursday 21st March at 6pm. All are welcome.** Refreshments are available afterwards in the Main Hall.
