**Trinity Sunday.** The Sunday after Pentecost carries this memo in the Liturgical Calendar for Scotland: Trinity Sunday is the "end of the period for the

fulfilment of Easter duties". Easter duties are among the things Church law requires of Catholics, and include receiving Holy Communion, if this is not done at some other point in the year. This gently reminds us that to go for a long period of time (more than a year...) without receiving Holy Communion is far from ideal. When the impediment has a moral cause — something we're doing that prevents us from receiving Communion in the state of grace — this law of the Church effectively encourages us to move forward towards conversion of heart, a good Confession and reconciliation with the family of God.
