The Sacred Heart of Jesus. This Friday is the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart. This important Catholic devotion spread widely after the 17th C and the revelations given by our Lord to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. **Our Lord** appeared to her and **promised** for souls devoted to His Sacred Heart:

- "I will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life."
- "I will establish peace in their homes."
- "I will comfort them in all their afflictions."
- "I will be their secure refuge during life, and above all in death."

- "I will bestow a large blessing upon all their undertakings."
- "Sinners shall find in My Heart the source and the infinite ocean of mercy."
- "Tepid souls shall grow fervent."
- "Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection."
- "I will bless every place where a picture of My Heart shall be set up and honoured."
- "I will give to priests the gifts of touching the most hardened hearts."
- "Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be effaced."
- "I promise you in the excessive mercy of My Heart that My all-powerful love will grant to all those who communicate on the First Friday in nine consecutive months the grace of final penitence; they shall not die in My disgrace nor without receiving their sacraments; My divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment."

This last promise is awesome! However, we need to be "true" devotees of the Sacred Heart – not "false" ones, going through the outward motions without any real desire to conform our own hearts to His.

The Immaculate Heart of Mary. The best way to live devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is through Mary! And so we're going to **consecrate our parish communities once again to the Immaculate Heart of Mary at the Sunday Masses of the weekend 8th/9th June.**

When we consecrate an institution like a parish to Mary, we are really consecrating *ourselves*. **We offer ourselves to the Bl. Virgin with the trust of little children, asking Her to accept all that we are and have as Her very own, and to guide and protect us.** In return, She will smooth the way to God and eternal life by **disposing our hearts inwardly to cooperate with His grace. It is hard to overestimate the importance of consecration to Mary.** It just resolves so many of life's problems! There is no problem or difficulty that She cannot overcome.
