Which English writer and broadcaster who died in 1990 at the age of 87 wrote a book called 'Conversion, a Spiritual Journey' after he became a Catholic?

Answer: Thomas Malcolm Muggeridge who was an English journalist and satirist. In his twenties, Muggeridge was attracted to communism, and in the 1930s went to live in the Soviet Union where the experience turned him into an anti-communist.

Muggeridge was received into the Catholic Church In 1982 at 79, after he had rejected Anglicanism. This

was largely under the influence of Mother Teresa about whom he had written a book, *Something Beautiful for God*, setting out and interpreting her life. His last book, *Conversion* (1988), describes his life as a 20th century pilgrimage, a spiritual journey.
