What is the published announcement, verbal or written, of a proposed marriage in an R.C. church?

Answer: The Banns of Marriage commonly known simply as the "banns" or "bans" (from a Middle English word meaning "proclamation", rooted in Frankish and thence in Old French), are the public announcement in a Christian parish church, or in a relevant council building, of an impending marriage between two specified persons. The purpose of banns is to enable anyone to raise any canonical or civil legal impediments to the marriage, to prevent invalid marriages.
