Advent. Today we enter the holy season of Advent, when we prepare for the coming of Christ at Christmas. Don't forget that *Christ*mas is all about *Christ* Jesus, the light of our lives! Christmas is truly joyful if we welcome Christ into our hearts and into our lives.

This is why Advent is so important. It is a time to do a bit of tidying up, setting in order, making things right... in ourselves, in our relationships with one another, and, above all, in our relationship with God.

Advent has a kind of penitential feel, and that's why we don't have flowers in the church for these few weeks, and the priest wears purple — as is also done in Lent, for the same reason. We want to show that we're sorry for anything we've done wrong, for the "sin that clings so closely" (Heb 12:1) — and that we are going to do our best, with God's help, to change for the better.

Going to Confession is a really big part of this journey of penance, personal growth, and preparation for Christmas!

On Thursday 12th December, at 6.30pm, Frs. Christopher and Bruno will lead an Advent penitential service at St. Mary's Church, Peterhead, and make themselves available for Confession in Polish (Fr. Chris), English, Italian, Spanish (Fr. Chris), and maybe a few other languages! (Fr. Chris).

Assisted Suicide Bill. Sadly, the assisted suicide bill was passed in the House of Commons on Friday. It looks set to become legally possible for terminally ill people in England and Wales to deliberately end their lives. This doesn't affect us immediately here in Scotland, but clearly there will now be pressure for the whole of the UK to offer the same provision.

Let us keep those tempted to end their own lives in our prayers, and do all we can to support them and help them see that their lives, and sufferings, are immensely precious, and can be extraordinarily fruitful.

May God reward all who campaigned or voted to keep the tragic injustice of euthanasia from Britain.
