As usual, **all Masses in November without a specific intention will be offered for the repose of all the souls recorded in our books of remembrance.**

**The Ring of Prayer** is a year-long rosary-based prayer ring around the UK, which forms part of **Stella Maris'** activities marking the Year of Prayer in 2024 leading up to the Jubilee Year in 2025 declared by Pope Francis. Recognising the importance of Our Lady to seafarers and fishers, and inspired by the coronation of Mary as honoured in the fifth decade of the Holy Rosary, the motivation for a ring of prayer around the country was formed. "A great and wondrous sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet and a crown of twelve stars on her head." (Rev 12:1) The sun, moon and stars have been used for centuries as critical navigational aids by seafarers – who often put their trust in Our Lady Star of the Sea for protection during their perilous journeys on the oceans. **Join us as we pray the Rosary after each of the weekday Masses in the week beginning 11<sup>th</sup> November.**
