New Lectionary. Next Sunday a new lectionary will be used at Masses throughout Scotland. The lectionary is the book with the readings for Mass.

Why do we need a new lectionary? It has to do with the translation of the Bible used for the readings. Some translations are a little closer to the meaning and form of the original Hebrew or Greek texts of the Bible. The translation used for most of the Bible in the new lectionary, the English Standard Version Catholic Edition (ESVCE), is one of these closer translations. You'll notice some differences from the English translation we have used for the last 50 years (the Jerusalem Bible). The Psalms in the new lectionary use a new version of the Grail translation. Both translations are excellent, but we will have to listen extra-carefully for a while, until we get used to them.

The Word of God speaks to us when the Bible is read in church. We are taught by Scripture, inspired and strengthened, and we praise God using the words which He Himself has given us in the Psalms. Let us take the opportunity presented by the new lectionary to renew our familiarity with and love for Sacred Scripture.

The missalettes we use will have the new readings from next Sunday.
