### Jubilee Indulgence.

#### The Bishop's Office writes:

Conditions for Obtaining the Jubilee Indulgence during the Ordinary Jubilee Year 2025:

During the Ordinary Jubilee of 2025, all the faithful, who are truly repentant and free from any affection for sin (cf. Enchiridion Indulgentiarum, IV ed., norm. 20, § 1), who are moved by a spirit of charity and who, during the Holy Year, purified through the sacrament of penance and refreshed by Holy Communion, pray for the intentions of the Holy Father (this prayer for the Pope's intentions is left to the choice of the individual, but an "Our Father" and a "Hail Mary" are suggested), will be able to obtain from the treasury of the church a plenary indulgence, with remission and forgiveness of all their sins, if they also undertake a pious pilgrimage or a pious visit to any sacred jubilee site. This Jubilee Plenary Indulgence can be also applied in suffrage to the souls in Purgatory.

**Where are the "sacred jubilee sites" in the Diocese of Aberdeen?** The Bishop has designated three: St. Mary's Church, Beauly IV4 7AU; Pluscarden Abbey; St. Mary's RC Cathedral, Aberdeen.

**What are "pious pilgrimages" and "pious visits"?** A pilgrimage involves participating devoutly at the site in public celebrations such as

Mass, morning or evening prayer, the way of the cross, the Rosary, or a penitential service ending with individual Confession. **A pious visit** involves devoutly visiting a jubilee site individually or in a group, and there, for a suitable period of time, engaging in Eucharistic adoration and meditation, concluding with the Our Father, the Profession of Faith in any legitimate form, and invocations to Mary, the Mother of God.

The Diocesan Pilgrimage to Pluscarden Abbey on 29th June would be an excellent opportunity to gain the jubilee indulgence.

Let's remember that the theme of the Jubilee Year is "Pilgrims of Hope". Trusting in God, courageously embracing His will in our lives, looking often to Jesus and Mary in our daily prayer: these are key to accessing the grace of this year.

Held on the Sunday closest to St. Valentine's Day, World Marriage Day is a beautiful opportunity to reflect on the blessing of married love. We pray for married couples that God may daily give them the strength and energy to support one another and their families. We especially pray that those who are experiencing difficulties in their relationship may seek help, either from [diocesan marriage counsellors](#) or from organisations such as [Retrouvaille](#).
