A Call to Penance to End Wars. "We were not born to kill, but to make peoples grow," said Pope Francis at his general audience last Wednesday, as he drew attention once again to conflicts in Ukraine, Myanmar, the Middle East, and other places in the world. "May paths of peace be found. Please, in your daily prayer, ask for peace... Please, let us pray for peace, let us do penance for peace".

These words of the Holy Father echo the call of our Lady at Fatima in 1917. She told the little seers Lucia, Jacinta and Francisco that God wanted prayer (especially the Rosary) and sacrifices so that wars might end, future wars might be avoided, and souls might be saved from eternal loss. Mary accurately predicted the beginning of the second World War more than 20 years before it actually broke out.

Let us heed the Holy Father's heartfelt appeal. As we begin to think about Lent, which begins on 5<sup>th</sup> March, perhaps we could think of some little sacrifice that each one of us could offer up most days, for the intention of peace and an end to war.

Thanks to all who participated in our recent parish pastoral council meetings. Come along to our next meetings in early June! Let's all make the

parish more and more a sign of God's love and goodness in the world!

**Wisdom of the Saints.** St. Leo the Great offers us some helpful reflections for the Feast of the Chair (Cathedra) of St. Peter this coming Saturday:

Jesus "continues: And I say to you. In other words, as my Father has revealed to you my godhead, so I in my turn make known to you your preeminence. You are Peter: though I am the inviolable rock, the cornerstone that makes both one, the foundation apart from which no one can lay any other, yet you also are a rock, for you are given solidity by my strength, so that which is my very own because of my power is common between us through your participation.

And upon this rock I will build my Church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. On this strong foundation, he says, I will build an everlasting temple. The great height of my Church, which is to penetrate the heavens, shall rise on the firm foundation of this faith...

Blessed Peter is therefore told: To you I will give the keys of the kingdom of heaven. Whatever you bind on earth is also bound in heaven. Whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed also in heaven.

The authority vested in this power passed also to the other apostles, and the institution established by this decree has been continued in all the leaders of the Church. But it is not without good reason that what is bestowed on all is entrusted to one. For Peter received it separately in trust because he is the prototype set before all the rulers of the Church."
