The Presentation of the Lord Jesus in the Temple. This Sunday we celebrate the last "feast of the child Jesus" - His presentation as a little baby of 40 days of age in the Temple. According to Old Testament Law, the first-born child was "offered" to the Lord with a small sacrifice, to commemorate the redemption of Israel from slavery in Egypt. New mothers would also approach the priest with an offering so that they could be declared ritually "clean". Jesus and Mary did both of these things, notwithstanding the fact that He is God, the very Author of the Law, and She is the virgin Mother of God, full of grace, immaculate. With this act of obedience and humility we can see the work of our Redemption beginning to unfold along the lines prophesied by the Psalmist many years before: "Sacrifice and offering you do not desire, but you have given me an open ear. Burnt-offering and sinoffering you have not required. Then I said, 'Here I am; in the scroll of the book it is written of me. I delight to do your will, O my God; your law is within my heart" (Ps 39/40). Jesus' obedient love does away with the injustice of human disobedience.
