Holy Week and Easter Services

Easter Octave weekday Masses, Mon-Sat 21st_26th April, are as usual, but each Mass will be preceded by the Divine Mercy chaplet and novena prayer.

On Divine Mercy Sunday itself there will be the usual devotions and holy hour at 3pm in St. Mary's Church, Peterhead. More about that next week!

What's Holy Week and Easter all about?

We're entering the most solemn week of the Church's liturgical year: Holy Week.

In this week's services, we **journey with our Lord Jesus** through the Last Supper to His agony in the garden Gethsemane (Thursday), and then to Calvary (Friday). We remember His burial and the time He spent in the tomb (Friday evening, Saturday). And finally, we celebrate with great joy His glorious Resurrection! (Saturday night and Sunday).

In these mysteries of His earthly life, Jesus shows us God's heart: how much He loves us; how much He desires our salvation; how willing He is to help us, forgive us, lift us up, make us sharers in His divine life!

Jesus spoke about His Passion to the 14th C mystic Julian of Norwich. "Then said our good Lord Jesus Christ to me – she wrote – : 'Are you well satisfied with my suffering for you?' And I said: 'Yes, good Lord, in your mercy. Yes, good Lord, may you be blessed for ever!' Then said Jesus, our kind Lord: 'If you are satisfied, I am satisfied. It is a joy, a bliss and an endless delight to me that I suffered my passion for you. And if it were needful or possible that I should suffer more.'"

He wanted to set us free from sin and the fear of death; He wanted to show us how much He loves us!

So let's draw very close to Him in these holy days. There's hardly a better way to do that than to participate in the Triduum Services (Thursday 7pm; Friday 3pm; Saturday 8:30pm). Let us offer Him our hearts! Wouldn't you want a friend to accompany you through difficult times? Let's show Jesus we're His friends!

Special blessings await those who walk with Him along the way of the cross. He will lead them to the joy of the Resurrection! "Jesus, triumph and reign!"

St. Faustina Kowalska, the Divine Mercy Saint, wrote about Jesus' sorrows in these poetic verses:

"O my Jesus, have mercy, sorrowful was Your life on this earth,

And in terrible torment Your work came to an end, Hanging stretched out on the wood of the Cross, And all this for the love of our souls.

In Your inconceivable love, You allowed Your most holy side to be opened,

And streams of Blood and Water gushed forth from Your Heart.

Here is the living fountain of Your mercy, Here souls receive consolation and refreshment." (Diary 1747)
