Patient's Religious Declaration. The Catholic Bishops of Scotland endorse this declaration, which is advisable for Catholics to carry in their purse or wallet, in case of an emergency admission to hospital. **Remember that if a Catholic doesn't ask for the Catholic priest to visit them in hospital, the nursing staff will not inform us about their stay.** But when we're in hospital, we need the Sacraments and support perhaps more than at other times. So carry this card with you and show it to the nurses as soon as you can: **Cut this out – Don't forget to sign it:**

Patient's Religious Declaration

I am a Roman Catholic.

While a patient in hospital, I wish to exercise my human right, as enshrined in the European Convention on Human Rights (Article 9.1), of practising my religion.

I request that the Roman Catholic Chaplain be informed of my admission to hospital, and that I receive a visit from the Roman Catholic Chaplain.

I give explicit consent for this information to be made available to the Roman Catholic Chaplain, and I would request that this document form part of my personal case notes.
