Euthanasia/Assisted Dying. There are now just 7 days until the Leadbeater assisted suicide Bill has the first day of its Second Reading in the House of Lords on Friday, 12 September. This debate will be

pivotal. Although no vote is typically held at Second Reading in the House of Lords, the debate next Friday will be crucial in determining the direction the Lords will take on this Bill. It's vital that as many Peers as possible attend and speak out against it. Over 200 Peers have already signed up to speak against assisted suicide, but we need to ensure even more do so — and that the overwhelming majority speak in opposition to the Bill. This Sunday Blesseds Carlo Acutis (+ 2006) and Piergiorgio Frassati (+ 1925) will be canonised by Pope Leo XIV in Rome. Carlo Acutis is the first saint of the millennial generation. This was how Carlo became so enthusiastic in various good works, from helping the poor to promoting Eucharistic miracles online.

St. Michael the Archangel. The wonderful prince of God's heavenly court, St. Michael, is commemorated liturgically at the end of this month, on 29th September, when he is remembered especially with Saints Gabriel and Raphael – two other great angel-lights in Heaven. The angels are spiritual beings who love God and are with Him in Heaven. They are our close friends and powerful helpers on the way of faith and holy love.
