Lobby Against Assisted Suicide. From the Catholic Parliamentary Office: You may recall that on 13th May, MSPs narrowly voted through Liam McArthur's Assisted Dying for Terminally III Adults (Scotland) Bill, by 70 votes to 56. The Bill is expected to return to Parliament in the coming weeks.


